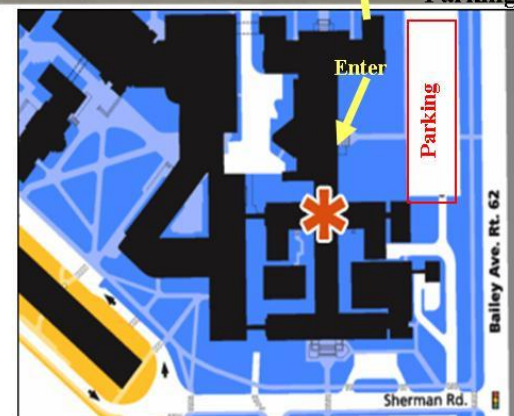
This is an interactive and practical workshop! Questions are encouraged throughout our time together.
