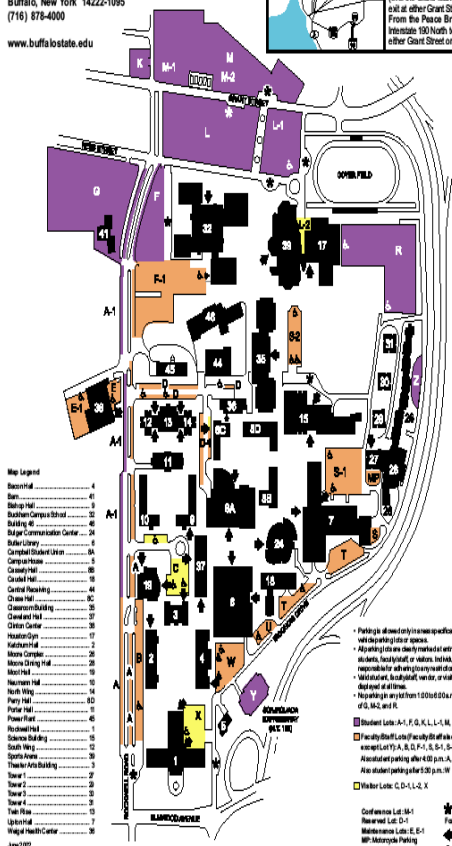

Learner Outcomes

At the conclusion of this session, participants will be able to:

1. Describe the rationale for and the processes implemented to establish the appropriate diagnosis and treatment of head and neck cancer.
2. Recognize the individual role of the multidisciplinary team members necessary to treat head and neck cancer.
3. Interpret how altered anatomy and function of the head and neck can challenge deglutition in head and neck cancer survivors.
4. Identify the clinical pathway for head and neck patients at Roswell Park Cancer Institute.

Presentation Description

This presentation will cover an overview of head and neck cancer from basic cancer cell biology through diagnosis and treatment. The role of a multidisciplinary team approach to patient management will be stressed. Unique examples of dysphagia will be reviewed to demonstrate how altered head and neck function and anatomy affects deglutition.
