Directions to Park Hall

NYS Thruway to I-290 West (Youngmann Expressway). Exit Millersport Highway North. Turn left at 1st signal (by the Marriott Hotel), continue to Flint Entrance of the UB Campus. Proceed straight thru 1st signal (Audubon Parkway), continue straight at the first top sign (Augsperger Rd). Parking available at the first lot on the right which is adjacent to Park Hall. You may also park along Flint Road.

From Canada, take the Lewiston Bridge to the I-190. From the Grand Island bridge, take the first exit which is the 1-290 east. Take the second Millersport Highway exit, and follow the directions above to get onto the campus.
