Teresa G. Casey, MS CCC-SLP, is currently the assistive technology (AT) team leader for the Williamsville Central School District. As such she is responsible for AT assessments, device procurement, AT training and implementation. Ms. Casey earned her Master's from Georgia State University. She is a co-author of *Hands-on Reading* and *More Hands-on Reading* and *Hands-on Reading Classroom Classics*. Ms. Casey presents frequently on the topic of AT.

Presentation Description

This in-service will provide an overview of available assistive technology tools and services for students with disabilities. AT definitions and legal mandates will be reviewed.
